Short Track

Expect some technical sections, and open sections. NEW COURSE

Men C/Women B	9:30 am	15min

Time Trial

A short but challenging course meant to test your bike handling skills and ability. Riders will encounter rocks, locks, off camber turns, and other obstacles. Riders will be started individually and will race against the clock. (Same course as last year, winning time was around 13min)

XC

Course consists of short motocross start to spread things out a little and the rest is some of the finest trails in WV. Expect tight twisty singletrack, loose rocky downhill, a couple sustained climbs, and the rest is fast and rolling. Start times are staggered by 5 minutes, with Men's A starting at 3pm.

Dual Slalom

Short course with jumps, bermed turns, and a starting gate. Qualifying will start at 9am and the race will start shortly after qualifiers. Course is located at the bottom of the DH course. Start time: 9:30 AM

Downhill

Starting 1hr after DS concludes: Racers meeting at the top prior to first run.

One course from last year, the other is brand new. The second run will start shortly after completion of the first using the same starting order. Order will be Men A, Men B, Women A, Men C and Women B.

Practice is available after 10am

Registration will be available Saturday at the community building of Big Bear 8-9:00 am. Registration will also be available before events: DH at the top of the mountain and DS by the rocks at the finish.

Racers wanting to participate in the A class MUST have a collegiate license that is upgraded to A.

Directions

To Big Bear:

24 miles east of Morgantown, I-68 Exit #29. Turn south off of the exit ramp and stay straight on that road for three miles. Check in at gate at camplands, staging will be at the community building just inside Big Bear.

Note: Races are being held in the mountains. Be prepared for possible cold weather and snow, you people from NC.

To WISP:

From I-68 take exit 14 towards Oakland MD 219 South. Drive~16 miles to McHenry. At the Exxon station make a right turn onto Sang Run Road. Take a left onto Marsh hill road. Turn right into the Wisp. Registration will be in the far left of the parking lot by the tubing park.

Accommodations: There is a new MicroTel off of exit 29. (Near Big Bear)
